As a public venue, Summit Chicago has always held the health & safety of our attendees and staff a top priority. The following outlines our standard operating procedures:

Summit staff educated on CDC guidelines and tips.

We have hand sanitizers at our front desk and have “Sanitation Stations” in our public areas.

We use a combination of hot water and bleach to clean our tables and surfaces multiple times a day.

Our restrooms are equipped with touchless soap and water taps, tissue boxes and waste baskets at the exit doors.

When we offer privacy rooms for guest calls or nursing mothers, we Clorox the phone and table surfaces prior to getting them settled.

Follow and exceed the Illinois ServSafe food and beverage procedures.

Michigan Plaza and Mbres Management are also implementing procedures to make our building a healthier and safer place:

Installed MERV-13 air filters (ASHRAE 2017b).

Implementing HVAC plan for air purging: providing re-occupancy purge of entire building volume with 100% outside air twice a day.

Disabled demand-controlled ventilation and opening outdoor air dampers to 100% as weather permits

Increased frequency of disinfecting public washrooms.

Deep clean of all lobby hard surfaces and seating.

Increased frequency of disinfecting lobby elevator call/floor buttons, railings, and escalator rails.

Added hand sanitizer dispensers in all main level elevator banks
